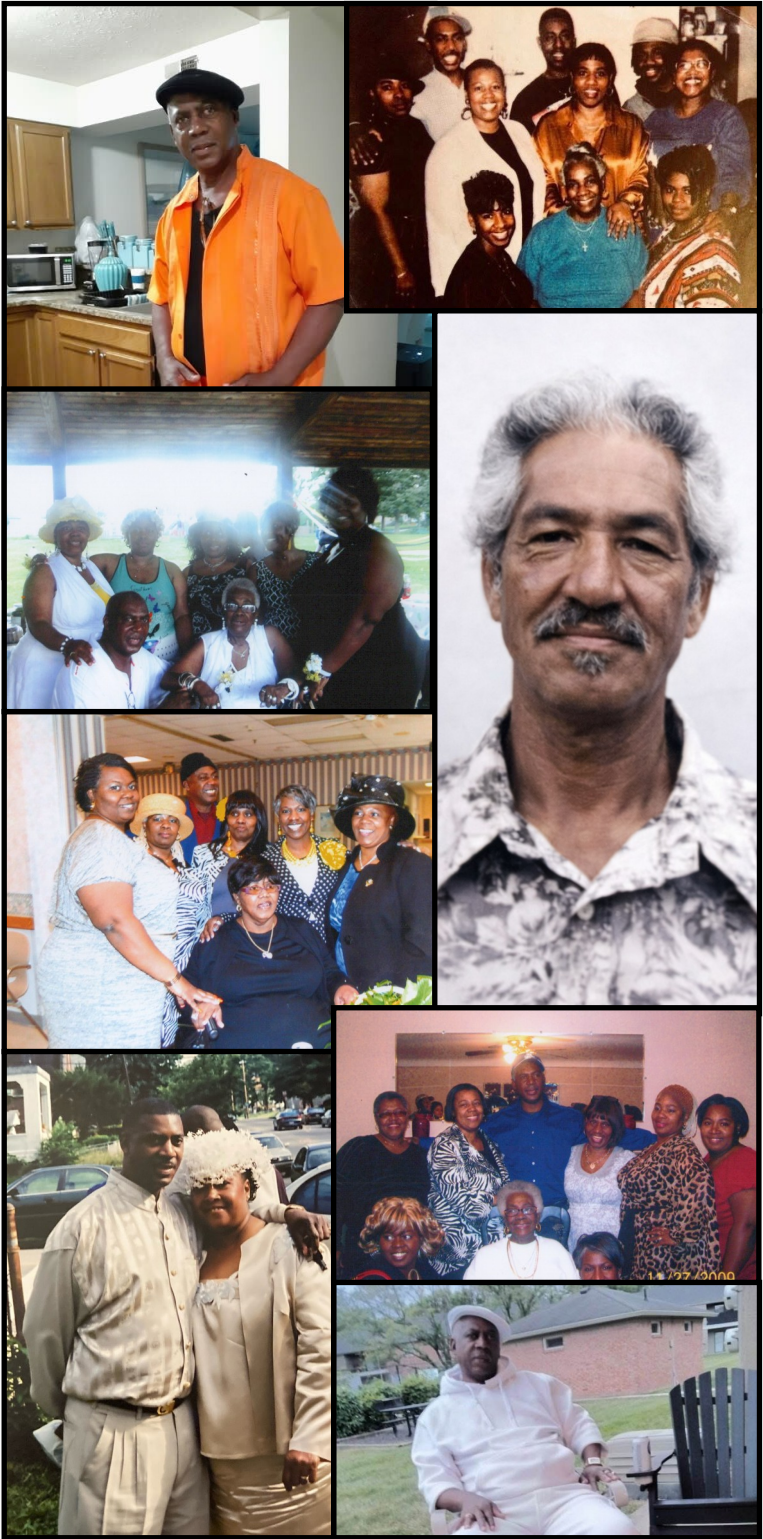
He departed this life for his heavenly home on June 17, 2026, at 9:05am, as God called his name, he answered!
