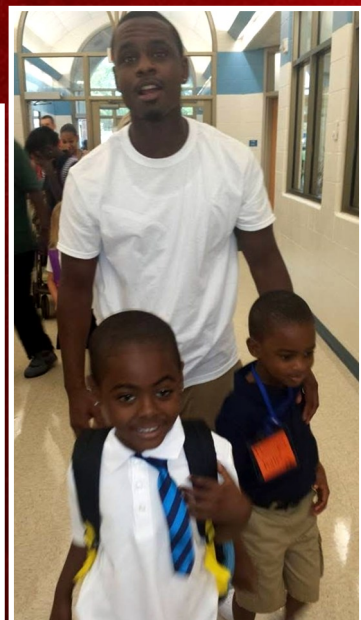
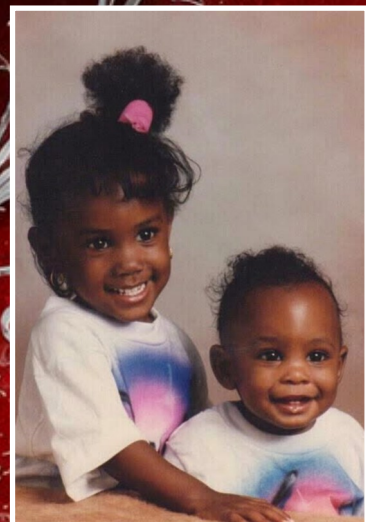

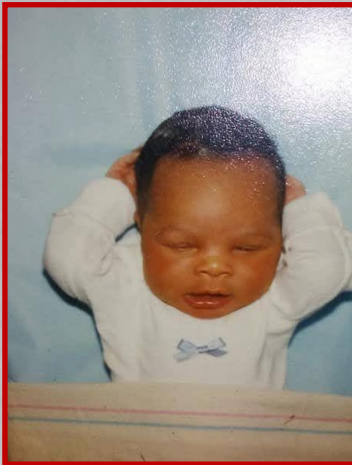
THE LIFE OF ANTHONY MINCEY
